Pro-President



António Paulino has been the Pro-President of the Polytechnic of Coimbra since September 2021.

In 2015 he received his master's degree in Electrotechnical Engineering with a specialisation in Computer Engineering from the Faculty of Sciences and Technology of the University of Coimbra. In 1999 he received his bachelor's degree in Electrotechnical Engineering with a specialisation in Telecommunications from the same university.

Between 2000 and 2002, he developed location systems for robots based on Computer Vision in the Institute for Systems and Robotics in Coimbra as a scholarship holder.

In 2002, he started teaching at Oliveira do Hospital Management and Technology School. He taught cours-

es in Electronics, Computer Networks and Computer Architecture until 2021. During this time, he trained in computer networks and became a certified CCNA trainer. He also took a training course from OutSystems in low-code applications development and received an Associate Reactive Developer certificate. He was responsible for the ESTGOH computer network from 2003 to 2020.

Between February 2012 and April 2012, he was elected President of ESTGOH's Technologies Department and resigned from his post to become Vice-President of ESTGOH, a position he held until November 2020. He was Interim President from November 2020 until February 2021, replacing the elected president of ESTGOH.
