Jorge Conde

President



Jorge Conde has been President of the Polytechnic of Coimbra since July 2017, and his mandate was renewed in July 2021.

Conde received his PhD in Sports Sciences, specialisation in Physical Activity and Health, in 2015 from the University of Coimbra. He became a Specialist Professor in Cardiopneumology in 2014 by the Polytechnic of Coimbra (in partnership with the Polytechnics of Lisbon and Porto). In 2003 Conde received his master's degree in Drug Addiction and Psychosocial Pathologies from the Miguel Torga Institute of Higher Education in Coimbra. He completed a specialised higher education course (CESE) in Teaching and Administration in 1997 from Coimbra Health School (Polytechnic of Coimbra). He also received his bachelor's degree in Cardiopneumology in 1984 from Coimbra Health School (Polytechnic of Coimbra).

Conde has been a teacher since 1986 and became a part-time Visiting Professor at the Polytechnic Institute of Castelo Branco (School of Health Dr Lopes Dias) between 2003 and 2007, and the Methodist University of Angola between 2012 and 2014. He has been a Coordinating Professor at IPC-ESTeSC since 2005, approved in a tender.

He has been a member of IPC's Management Board since 2008. He is also a member of the Permanent Commission of the Portuguese Polytechnics Coordinating Council (CCISP); Head of the Technical Commission of Health of CCISP; Representative of the Polytechnics of the Centre in Centre RIS3's Coordinating Council; a member of the Strategic Council for Inter-

municipal Development of the Intermunicipal Community of Coimbra Region; and a member of the board of the IPN Incubator (Pedro Nunes Institute).

Jorge Conde is President of the Academic Health Network of Lusophony and the President-designate of the X Ibero-American Network of Health Promoting Universities Congress to be held in October 2022.

He was President of Coimbra Health School between 2008 and 2017; member of IP's General Council from 2009 to 2017; member of the Scientific-Technical Council of Coimbra Health School from 1997 to 2017; President of the Assembly of Representatives of Coimbra Health School in 2007; President of the Scientific Committee of Clinical Physiology since its creation until 2017; Former Director of the Cardiopneumology Course of ESTeSC; Former Director of the Imaging and Bio-signals Sciences Department of ESTeSC; Former member of the A3ES working group for the reform of health technology teaching; Former Auditor of the Association of the Portuguese Polytechnics Institutes (ADISPOR).

He is also the Director of the ReVSalus Journal (Health Research), published over 80 articles, has over 50 abstracts published in events, and has given more than 100 lectures at congresses. In his scientific career, he has been a member of more than 50 organising committees of scientific events, half of which as President, jury president of more than 25 academic career competitions, and a member of around 10 masters and PhD juries.
