Bolsa de Iniciação à Investigação 3 / Research Grant 3 _ 2020 (IPC-ESE/UNICID/SLT-Grant 3-2020)

Sport, Leisure and Tourism

Considering the research plan of Applied Sport Sciences Research Unit (ASSERT) (<https://assertesec.wixsite.com/assert>) from Coimbra Education School of the Polytechnic Institute of Coimbra - Unidade de Investigação Aplicada em Ciências do Desporto (UNICID) do Instituto Politécnico de Coimbra - Escola Superior de Educação (ESE) -, a research position for one Research Grant (Bolsa de Iniciação à Investigação) is opened at IPC-ESE in the scope of Sport, Leisure and Tourism (*one of the three major domains of Sport Sciences and Human Behaviour*), financed by the ESE-IPC. The grant will be awarded under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Sports Sciences

Admission requirements: The candidate should be Undergraduate (1^o cycle of studies in Higher Education leading to the academic degree of *licenciado*) student in Sports Sciences or Physical Education.

Work Plan and Objectives: The aim of this grant is to collect data from “Granfondo” and trail running athletes during a period of 3 months. Data collection will be made with digital inquiries to the athletes and by phone interviews to local hosting facilities. The goal is to study the profile, motivations of cycling and trail running practitioners, the devices used during for training and competition, the nature of the involvement in this kind of activities and the push factors around the area where the competition happens. Moreover, data will be used to produce scientific articles.

Duration: The research grant will have the duration of 3 months, with foreseen start date in 01-11-2020, in exclusive regime.

Legislation and regulations applicable: A fellowship will be celebrated according to the regulations defined by FCT and "Regulation of Instituto Politécnico de Coimbra fellowships", approved by Regulation n.º 12709/2016, published in Series II of Diário da República of September 21 of 2016.

Value for monthly allowance: 412 Eur (net), according to table values (Tabela de Subsídios Relativos a Bolsas aprovadas ao abrigo do Regulamento N.º 950/2019, de 16 de dezembro) of the scholarships awarded directly by the FCT, in the country (www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores). The payment will be made by bank transfer.

Place of work: Activities will be developed in the Unidade de Investigação Aplicada em Ciências do Desporto (Polos I and II of Escola Superior de Educação – Instituto Politécnico de Coimbra, Portugal).

Scientific advisor: PhD Professor António Sérgio Damásio.

Selection methods: Selection of the candidates will be performed by evaluation of the curriculum (70%) and an interview (30%) in English. The curriculum evaluation will consider the following parameters: 1) Merit of the candidate (30%), 2) adequacy of the Curriculum Vitae (60%) to the activities to be developed, considering previous experience in i) technologies and instruments for sport and performance analysis and, ii) data treatment and 3) the candidate's motivation expressed in the Motivation Letter (10%). The candidate should be fluent in English, with good writing and spoken skills, as well as interest on scientific research.

Jury: The jury will be composed by PhD Professor Fernando Manuel Lourenço Martins (presiding), PhD Professor António Sérgio Damásio and PHD Professor Ricardo Gomes. Professor PhD Francisco Ascenco Campos and Professor PhD Artur Martins will be alternate members of the jury.

Documents: To submit the application the candidates should submit the documentation to be included in the announcement of the opening of the competition, namely: a) Identification, residence, identification document number and tax identification number; b) Documents proving that the applicant meets the conditions required for the respective type of scholarship, namely, certificate of frequency of a undergraduation degree in Sports Sciences or Physical Education; c) Curriculum vitae of the candidate; d) Two letters of reference or two recommendation letters for grant ; e) Motivation letter.

Deadlines: The period for submitting applications is from 25-09-2020 to 09-10-2020.
